

Recommended applications: For Research use only. RNA or protein endometrium cancer/non-tumor tissue profiling using IHC or ISH; Antibody characterization.

Description: Endometrial cancer tissue array with progressive changes, 150 cores, non-overlapping with EMC1501, including 23 cases of normal, 7 cases of hyperplasia and 45 cases of duplicated neoplastic tissues of the endometrium.

All the tissues were from surgical resection. They were fixed in 10% neutral buffered formalin for 24 hours and processed using identical SOPs. Sections were picked onto Superfrost Plus or APES coated Superfrost slides. They can be stored for use at 4C for up to six months from the date of shipment. **There may be 5 to 10% of tissue core loss.**

TNM Classification: Endometrium carcinoma

T- Primary tumor

TX - Primary tumor cannot be assessed

T0 - No evidence of primary tumor

Tis - Carcinoma in situ (preinvasive carcinoma)

T1 - Tumor confined to corpus uteri

T1a - Tumor limited to endometrium

T1 b - Tumor invades up to less than one half of myometrium

T1c - Tumor invades to more than one half of myometrium

T2 - Tumor invades cervix but does not extend beyond uterus

T2a - Endocervical glandular involvement only

T2b - Cervical stromal invasion

T3 (and/or N1) - Local or regional spread as specified below

T3a - Tumor involve serosa and/or adnexa and/or cancer cells in ascites or peritoneal washing

T3b - Vaginal involvement

(N1) - Metastasis to pelvic and/or para-aortic lymph nodes

T4 - Tumor invades bladder mucosa and/or bowel mucosa

N - Regional lymph nodes

NX - Regional lymph nodes cannot be assessed

NO - No regional lymph node metastasis

Regional lymph node metastasis

N1a - Metastasis in a single regional lymph node

N1b - Metastasis in multiple regional lymph nodes

M - Distant metastasis

MX - Distant metastasis cannot be assessed

MO - No distant metastasis

M1 - Distant metastasis
