

Recommended applications: For Research use only. RNA or protein breast cancer/non-tumor tissue profiling using IHC or ISH; Antibody characterization.

Description: Breast cancer tissue array, 102 cases of normal (5 cases) and cancer (97 cases) tissues with grading and staging data.

All the tissues were from surgical resection. They were fixed in 10% neutral buffered formalin for 24 hours and processed using identical SOPs. Sections were picked onto Superfrost Plus or APES coated Superfrost slides. They can be stored for use at 4C for up to six months from the date of shipment. **There may be 5 to 10% of tissue core loss.**

T- Primary tumor

TX - Primary tumor cannot be assessed

TO - No evidence of primary tumor

Tis - Carcinoma in situ, intraductal carcinoma or lobular carcinoma in situ, or Paget's disease of the nipple with no tumor

T1 - Tumor 2 cm or less in greatest dimension

T2 - Tumor more than 2 cm but not more than 5 cm in greatest dimension T3 -

Tumor more than 5 cm in greatest dimension

T4 - Tumor of any size with direct extension to chest wall or skin
