


Recommended applications: For Research use only. RNA or protein endometrium cancer/non-tumor tissue profiling using IHC or ISH; Antibody characterization.

Description: Endometrial cancer tissue array, non-overlapping with EMC961, including 48 cases of uninvolved and cancerous tissues of the endometrium in duplicates.

All the tissues were from surgical resection. They were fixed in 10% neutral buffered formalin for 24 hours and processed using identical SOPs. Sections were picked onto Superfrost Plus or APES coated Superfrost slides. They can be stored for use at 4C for up to six months from the date of shipment. **There may be 5 to 10% of tissue core loss.**

TNM Classification: Endometrium carcinoma

T- Primary tumor

- TX - Primary tumor cannot be assessed
- TO - No evidence of primary tumor
- Tis - Carcinoma in situ (preinvasive carcinoma)
- T1 - Tumor confined to corpus uteri
 - T1a - Tumor limited to endometrium
 - T1 b - Tumor invades up to less than one half of myometrium
 - T1c - Tumor invades to more than one half of myometrium
- T2 - Tumor invades cervix but does not extend beyond uterus
 - T2a - Endocervical glandular involvement only
 - T2b - Cervical stromal invasion
- T3 (and/or N1) - Local or regional spread as specified below
 - T3a - Tumor involves serosa and/or adnexa and/or cancer cells in ascites or peritoneal washing
 - T3b - Vaginal involvement
- (N1) - Metastasis to pelvic and/or para-aortic lymph nodes
- T4 - Tumor invades bladder mucosa and/or bowel mucosa

N - Regional lymph nodes

- NX - Regional lymph nodes cannot be assessed
- NO - No regional lymph node metastasis
- N1 - Regional lymph node metastasis
 - N1a - Metastasis in a single regional lymph node
 - N1b - Metastasis in multiple regional lymph nodes

M - Distant metastasis

- MX - Distant metastasis cannot be assessed
- MO - No distant metastasis
- M1 - Distant metastasis
